



RESOLUTION NO. 2025-137

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CITY'S GRANTS POLICY TO INCREASE THE CITY MANAGER'S AUTHORIZATION FOR GRANT APPLICATION AND GRANT ACCEPTANCE AUTHORITY FROM \$50,000 TO \$100,000.

WHEREAS, the City of Farmers Branch, Texas (the "City"), is a local government of the State of Texas, and in following the 89th Regular Legislative Session changes, held a FY26 Budget Work Session discussion on June 24, 2025, where the City reviewed the City's grant policy, and

WHEREAS, the Farmers Branch City Council was presented with information related to the City Manager's grant authority and discussed options to increase that authority, and

WHEREAS, the Farmer Branch City Council directed staff to bring back an amendment to the City's grant policy to increase the City Manager's authorization for grant application and grant acceptance authority from \$50,000 to \$100,000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

SECTION 2. The City of Farmers Branch Grant Policy is hereby amended to increase the City Manager's authorization for grant application and grant acceptance authority from \$50,000 to \$100,000.

SECTION 3. Should any section or part of this Resolution be held unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, or the application to any person or circumstance thereof ineffective or inapplicable, such unconstitutionality, illegality, invalidity, or ineffectiveness of such section or part shall in no way affect, impair or invalidate the remaining portion or portions thereof; but as to such remaining portion or portions, the same shall be and remain in full force and effect and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared severable.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and shall continue in full force and effect until amended or revoked by the City of Farmers Branch, Texas.
