Background



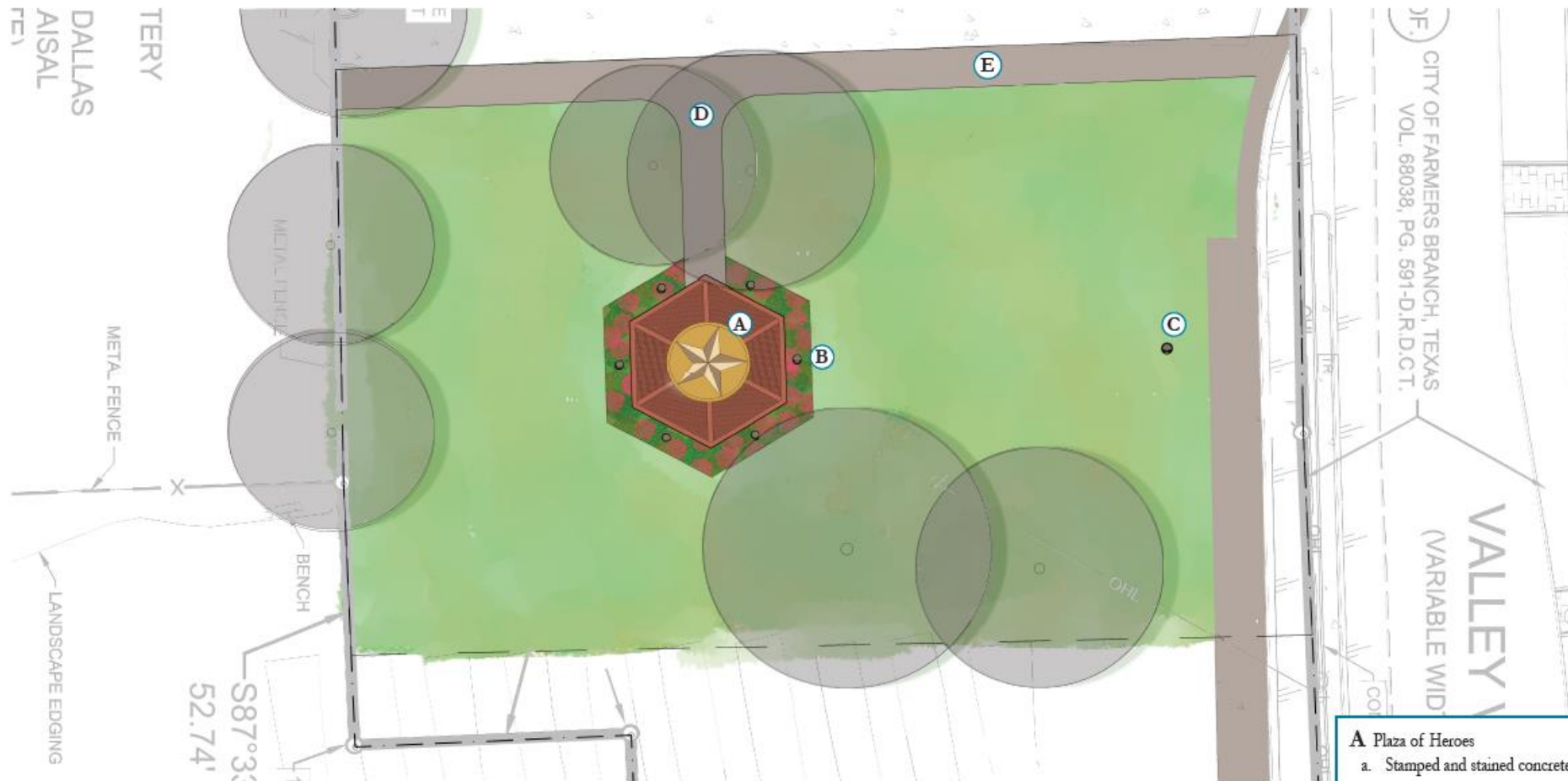
1 Requested by Councilwoman Tina Bennett-Burton as a future agenda item at the November 18, 2025, City Council Meeting.

2 Staff reviewed three possible locations at a City Council Study Session on February 3, 2026.

3 City Council suggested the lot adjacent to the Rose Garden/Keenan Cemetery and requested staff bring back concepts and cost estimates.

4 Staff will review two conceptual design options with the City Council at the July 7, 2026, City Council Study Session.

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Estimated Costs

Concept A-\$300,000

Features: Paved plaza, flags, and connectivity to the parking area.

Concept B-\$400,000

Features: Larger paved area, separate flag areas, and a similar design to the current Liberty Plaza.

Key Factors:

- Use a phased approach, reducing budget impact and allowing efficient use of staff.
- Use a combination of in-house staff with expert contractors.
- Utilize the most cost-effective materials.
- Both designs allow for future improvements.
