A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND A MANIKIN FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FROM BOUND TREE MEDICAL, LLC; THROUGH A COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT CITY MIDLOTHIAN; WITH THE OF AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF SAID COOPERATIVE PURCHASING **AGREEMENT: AND PROVIDING** EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS; the FY 2022-23 Budget appropriates \$161,000 to purchase medical supplies and equipment for the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, City Administration has determined that the necessary medical supplies and a manikin to be used in the operations of the Fire Department can be obtained at a fair and reasonable price from Bound Tree Medical, LLC, through a cooperative purchasing agreement with the City of Midlothian, Texas; and

WHEREAS, City Administration anticipates an expenditure in excess of \$50,000 during the 2022-23 Fiscal Year for medical supplies for Fire Department operations and recommends such purchases be made from Bound Tree Medical, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch finds it to be in the public interest to concur in the foregoing recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Subject to applicable state law and the availability of funds in the City's 2022-23 Fiscal Year budget for such purposes, the Interim City Manager is hereby authorized to take such action as necessary to purchase medical supplies and a manikin for use in Fire Department operations from Bound Tree Medical, LLC in an amount exceeding \$50,000 through a cooperative purchasing agreement with the City of Midlothian, which cooperative purchasing agreement the City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
