## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-237**



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF CHAIRS AND STACKING CARTS FOR USE AT THE BRANCH CONNECTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$29,945.74 AND ASSEMBLY SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,989.00, FOR A TOTAL PRICE OF \$32,934.74; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE AGREEMENTS AND PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT ON THE CITY'S BEHALF; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, City staff has determined, and the City Council concurs, that it is necessary to purchase and acquire new chairs and stacking carts/dollies for activities and events at the Branch Connection; and

WHEREAS, after soliciting quotes from qualified vendors, City staff has recommended the purchase of chairs and equipment in the total amount of \$29,945.74 from Uline, and assembly services in the amount of \$2,989.00 from Seroz Construction, for an aggregate price of \$32,934.74, in accordance with the quotes attached as Exhibit "A" hereto; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, upon full review and consideration of the proposed procurement and all matters related thereto, is of the opinion and finds that the quotes should be accepted and that the City Manager, or designee, should be authorized to accept the quotes and accomplish the purchase of the items and services described therein, which the Council finds and determines are in the best interests of the citizens of the City.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

**SECTION 1**: The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept and approve the purchase of chairs, stacking carts, and related services in the total amount of \$32,934.74 from Uline and Seroz Construction according to the quotes attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and is further authorized provide for payment and to sign on the City's behalf any necessary or appropriate documents and accept and approve such contract amendments as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, in the public interest, in compliance with applicable law and City policy, and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of funds.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage as the law and charter in such cases provide.
