



**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-035**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, FOR THE PROVISION OF MATCHING FUNDS OF \$30,000 EACH, AND THE APPLICATION AND USE OF GRANT PROCEEDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$240,000 FROM THE MOTOR VEHICLE CRIME PREVENTION AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TEXAS (MVCPA) GRANT PROGRAM, FOR JOINT PARTICIPATION IN AN AUTO CRIME TASK FORCE AND THE PROCUREMENT OF A DRONES AS FIRST RESPONDER SYSTEM FROM FLOCK GROUP, INC.; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND PROVIDE FOR PAYMENTS ON THE CITY'S BEHALF; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, City staff has proposed and recommends participation in an Auto Crime Task Force, the goal of which will be a collaborative effort between the City and the City of Carrollton, Texas, to establish a multi-agency task force to detect, investigate, prevent and prosecute motor vehicle crimes; and

**WHEREAS**, an essential component of the collaborative effort is the acquisition and operation of a Drones as First Responder (DFR) 2.0 system from Flock Group, Inc., which, if approved, will be installed, maintained and operated at a mutually agreeable location in the City of Farmers Branch; and

**WHEREAS**, the DRF 2.0 system is available at a cost of \$300,000, which is proposed to be paid by Farmers Branch and partially reimbursed with a matching contribution of \$30,000 from Carrollton, and grant funding under the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority of the State of Texas (MVCPA) grant program in the amount of \$240,000; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff has proposed and recommends approval of an interlocal cooperation agreement between Farmers Branch and Carrollton, the approval of which the City Council finds to be in the City's and public's best interests; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that it is in the public interest to accept and approve the Carrollton-Farmers Branch Auto Theft Task Force Interlocal Agreement, incorporated in and made a part hereof.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Carrollton-Farmers Branch Auto Theft Task Force Interlocal Agreement, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, be and is hereby approved and accepted, and the City Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement on the City's

behalf, to provide for payment for the procurement of the Drones as First Responders (DFR) 2.0 system from Flock Group, Inc., in the amount of \$300,000, to submit application for grant funding under the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority of the State of Texas (MVCPA) grant program as partial reimbursement, to commit matching funds in the amount of \$30,000, and to agree to such changes and amendments as the City Manager determines to be reasonable and necessary in compliance with state law and city policies and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of current funds.

**SECTION 2.** This resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
