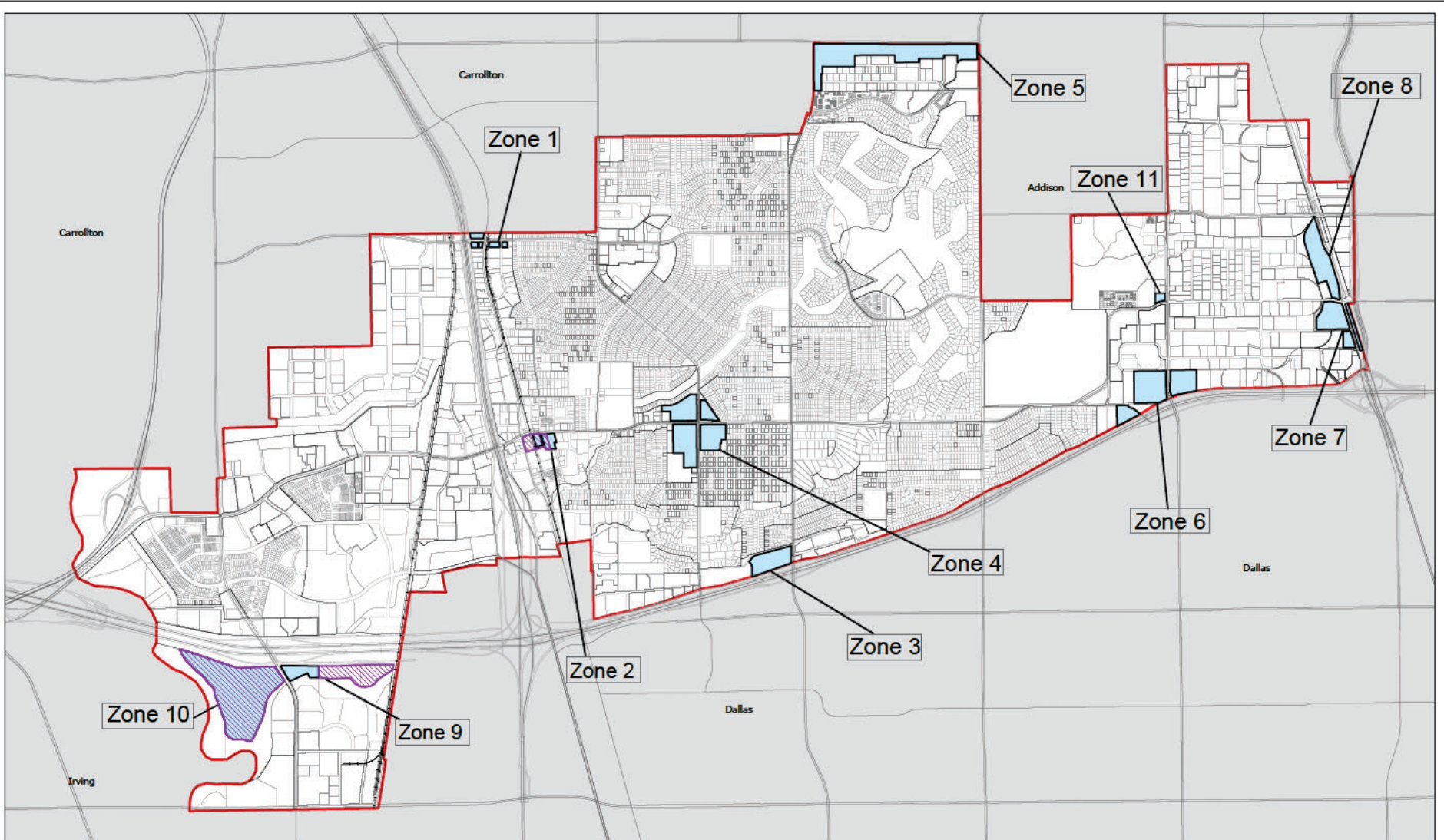

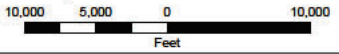

Issues: 25-SU-10 and 26-ZA-01 – new QuikTrip with beer/wine sales.

Dear Planning & Zoning Commission: I am a resident of Farmers Branch at 3917 Clubway Lane. I am barely outside of the notification area, but live in the neighborhood and my work commute takes me past this intersection.

I am in favor of the new QuikTrip station, and if that means they will sell beer and wine, then I am also in favor of this zoning change. I believe that such a convenience store would be a great benefit to a part of the city that is rapidly growing (thanks to all the new apartments), and in a “food desert” since we don’t have any grocery stores in the area. This store will offer services that are currently being filled in Addison and Dallas.

My only complaint is that I cannot turn left from Eastbound Alpha into the parking lot. Entering the store in the morning (or just stopping by to get gas), requires turning onto Sigma, driving past Parish Episcopal School traffic, turning into an apartment complex driveway, and navigating through the strip mall. A traffic signal enabling people to exit the parking lot at the Jimmy John’s entrance, would protect those needing to continue North on Midway, without having to navigate back out to Sigma with the Parish traffic. There are lights nearby, but all of Midway is a racetrack during the morning commute.

Parish Episcopal School (the “School”) would like to summarize our position regarding the proposed zoning change and subsequent installation of a gas station and convenience store at the corner of Midway Road and Alpha Road.

The School’s safety concerns over the re-zoning proposal was expressed to the City Council last spring. The School continues to have significant concerns about the additional vehicle traffic that will arise from a new business on that corner. We would encourage the Commission to think about the traffic flow that would go North from the proposed store. We believe Sigma Road traffic will increase significantly as customers use the road to get back to Midway Road to go North. The impact to traffic, especially during morning and afternoon carpool, athletic and other school events and the related danger to the students, who use that road regularly (on foot and in vehicles) to use the fields on the 6.2 acres owned by the School cannot be offset by any additional revenues to the City.

Regardless of the future business’ use of Sigma Road, the School remains deeply concerned, including left turns out of the business onto Alpha Road. Furthermore, the additional traffic could certainly create a more dangerous environment for our community, especially those that access Midway via Alpha, and vice versa.

During the City Council hearing last spring, the School and other entities impacted directly by this zoning change, and new business were assured that a proper and thorough traffic study would be conducted before this project moved forward. To be clear, the School has not been contacted about this, nor has it been notified of any findings of the proper study.

Moreover, once again, the City was non-communicative with the School about the upcoming PnZ hearing, which impacts the School’s ability to make a fully informed decision. We would welcome a partnership with the City in which we have all the facts and studies that may inform our position on the proposal.

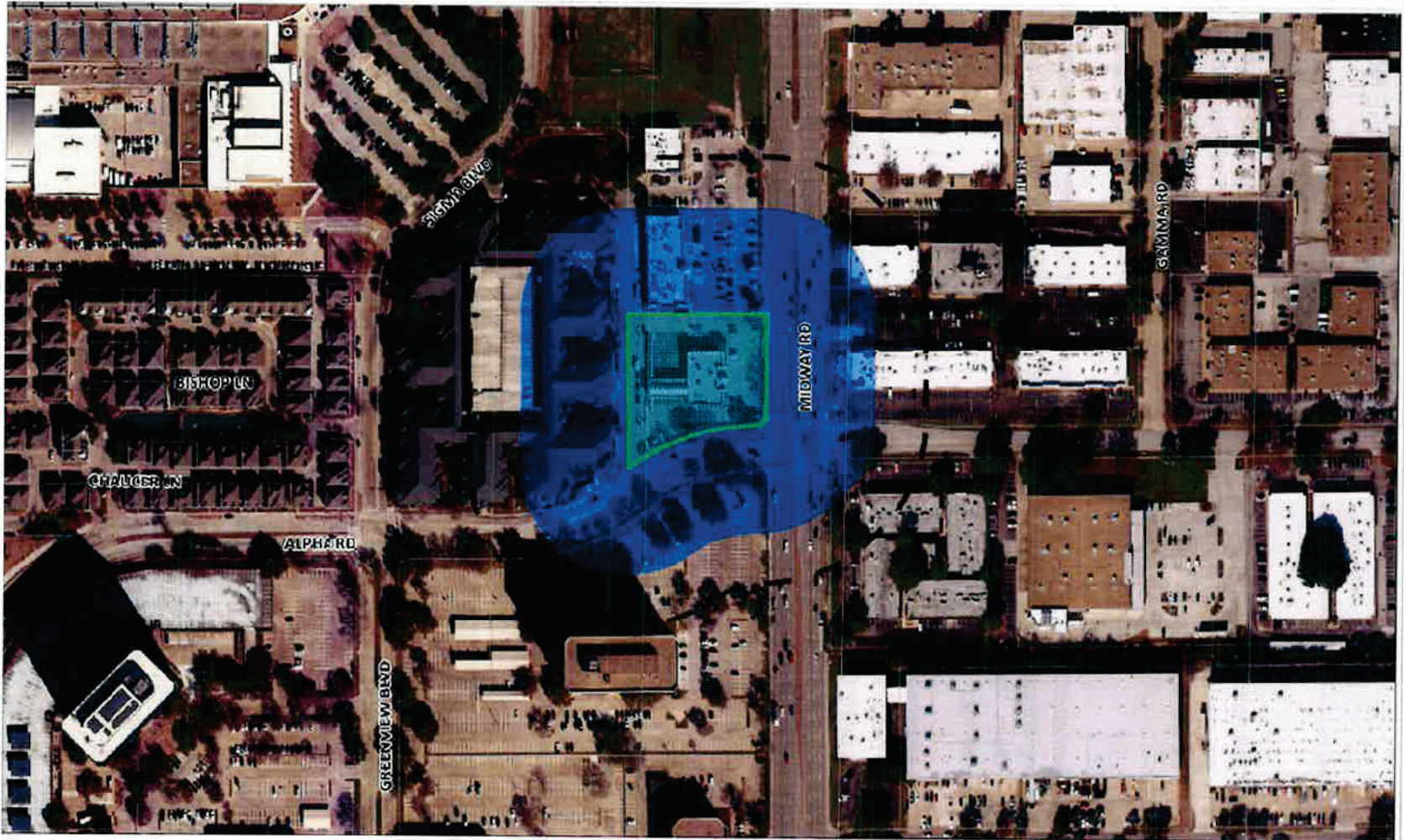
Additionally, the School still has the same additional security concerns over alcohol sales, foot traffic, and related 24 hour a day operations of the convenience store so close to the School itself.






The School remains steadfast in opposing the revised SUP for the site. There’s a reason properties are zoned a certain way and we believe the change is detrimental without understanding the why and the numerous deleterious effects to physical safety for our community.

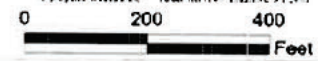

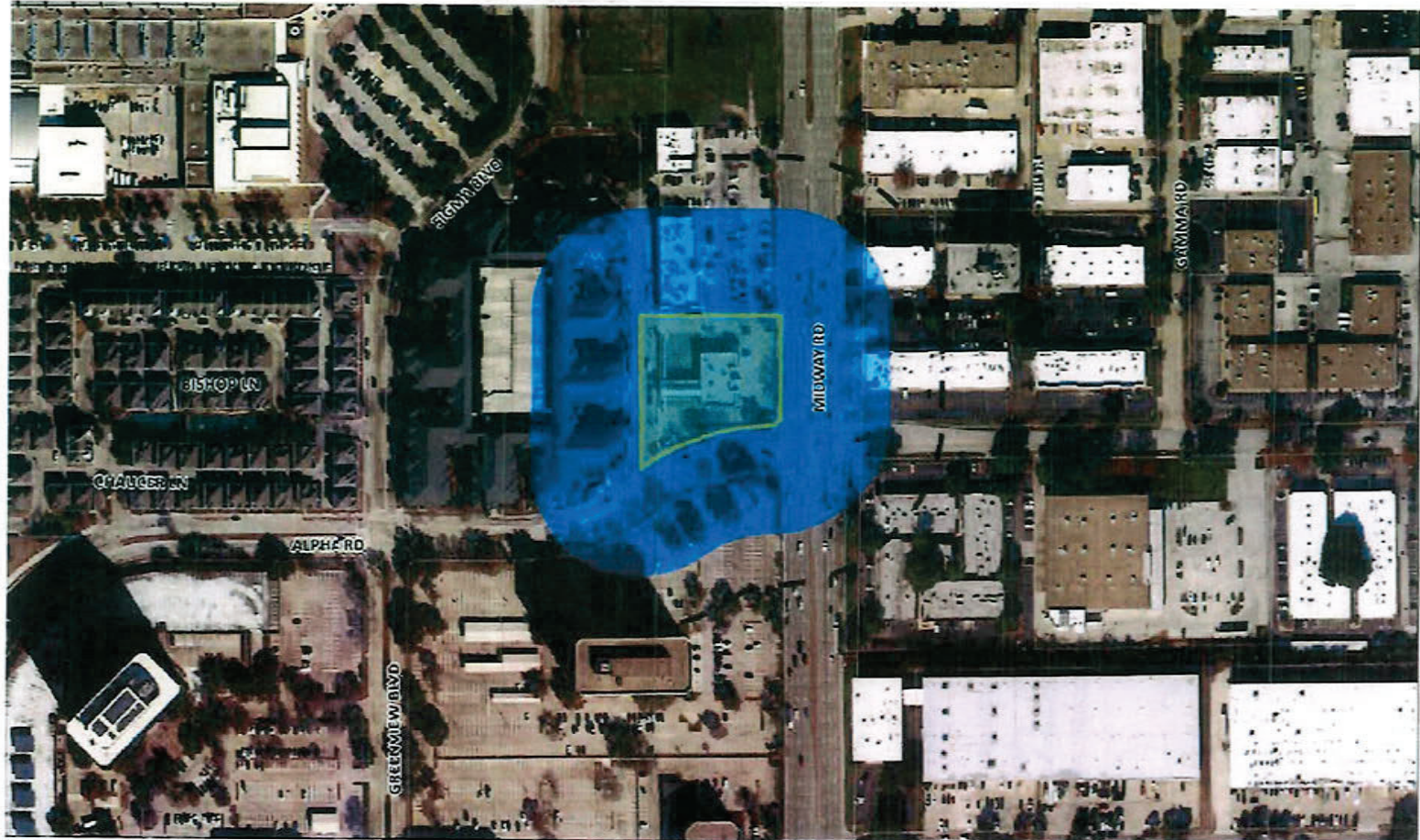

Good Evening Chair and Commissioners,

My name is Steve Flens, and I represent MW3 BP Associates, LLC owners of Midway Commons Shopping Center at 13605 Midway Road adjacent to the proposed development.

I am here to formally state our opposition to Case No. 25-SU-10, the request for a Specific Use Permit and zoning amendment to allow QuikTrip to construct a gas station at 13601 Midway Road and respectfully request that the Commission deny this request.

**1) The intensity of the requested use is disproportionate to the site's size.**

Quick Trip developments are commonly located on parcels of approximately **2 acres or more**. This site is only **1.47 acres**, which is unusually small for the intensity of this proposed use and increases the risk of circulation, stacking, and traffic safety failures. On a parcel this small, circulation and stacking failures are likely and foreseeable, including:

- insufficient queueing and internal circulation
- blocked access drives and congestion at driveways
- conflicts between customer vehicles and delivery trucks
- proper turning radii for tankers

This is not speculative—it is a predictable site constraint problem. Even if QT is “good at traffic,” the land area itself is the limiting factor.

**2) Traffic operations and safety impacts are substantial and unresolved.**

A gas station is a high-turnover use, and this location is already located on a major corridor. The key operational question is how vehicles will safely exit and travel northbound on Midway Road without creating unsafe left-turn maneuvers, rerouting/U-turn congestion, and added conflict points.

The site plan lists **5 - 15K gallon underground fuel tanks**. This development is **not a small corner store**—it is designed for significant fuel volume and turnover, which correlates directly with:

- Higher daily traffic counts (Midway ~ 50,000 VPD per 2045 Comprehensive Plan)
- More frequent turning movements
- Larger delivery vehicle requirements (fuel trucks, box trucks, etc.)
- Longer operating hours activity

Per Placer.ai, the **3 closest QT's to this proposed location averaged approximately 1,150,000 site visits in 2025**. As a comparison, the **Tom Thumb located 2.5 miles south at 3757 Forest Ln saw 861,000 total site visits last year**.

### **3) The request is inconsistent with long-term planning objectives.**

The proposed QuikTrip gas station at 13601 Midway Road conflicts with the long-range vision and land use recommendations established in the City's adopted planning documents. The Farmers Branch East Side Comprehensive Plan emphasizes a mixed-use, people-oriented district identity and specifically directs the City to ensure new development is compatible with surrounding uses and form. **A 20-pump gas station on a 1.47-acre tract is an auto-intensive use that will generate traffic, stacking, driveway conflicts, lighting, and delivery truck impacts that are inconsistent with that vision and compatibility policy.** This development would **create a long-term land use constraint** that would be difficult to reverse or redevelop into mixed-use later. Additionally, the City's of Farmers Branch 2045 Plan is intended to guide long-term development outcomes citywide over the next 20 years, and this request would approve a low-flexibility convenience use that undermines cohesive redevelopment goals and creates land use and mobility impacts contrary to those planning objectives.

### **4) The proposal conflicts with recorded private restrictions governing the property.**

This development would violate the recorded Declaration of Covenants, Restrictions and Easements governing Prairie Crossing. Section 5.1 (Use Restrictions) states that the Retail Parcel shall only be used for retail purposes consistent with the operation of a first-class retail shopping center, and further prohibits objectionable uses that may be hazardous or disruptive due to fumes, soil pollution, or hazards such as fire or explosion. A high-volume gas station with extensive underground fuel storage and fueling activity is not consistent with a first-class retail shopping center use and introduces the exact type of hazardous and incompatible impacts these restrictions were intended to prevent. **A QuikTrip is not "shopping center retail."** It is an **automotive-oriented fuel sales facility** with high daily traffic volumes, tanker deliveries, 24-hour operations, and continuous storage of hazardous material. This parcel is intended to be developed and operated as a **residential and/or commercial mixed-use development**.

This is not merely a zoning compatibility issue—this proposal conflicts with existing recorded use restrictions governing the property.

A Specific Use Permit does not cure a private covenant violation, and the City should not approve discretionary land use relief that enables a use prohibited by recorded restrictions

The current tenant of this building is an early intervention provider of individualized therapy for children with autism which benefits the local community and is an appropriate use for this site.

For these reasons, I respectfully request the Commission recommend denial of Case No. 25-SU-10.

If the Commission is not prepared to deny the request tonight, then I request a continuance until the applicant provides definitive proof of compliance with the recorded restrictions and a traffic analysis demonstrating safe access and circulation, particularly for vehicles traveling northbound and southbound on Midway Road.

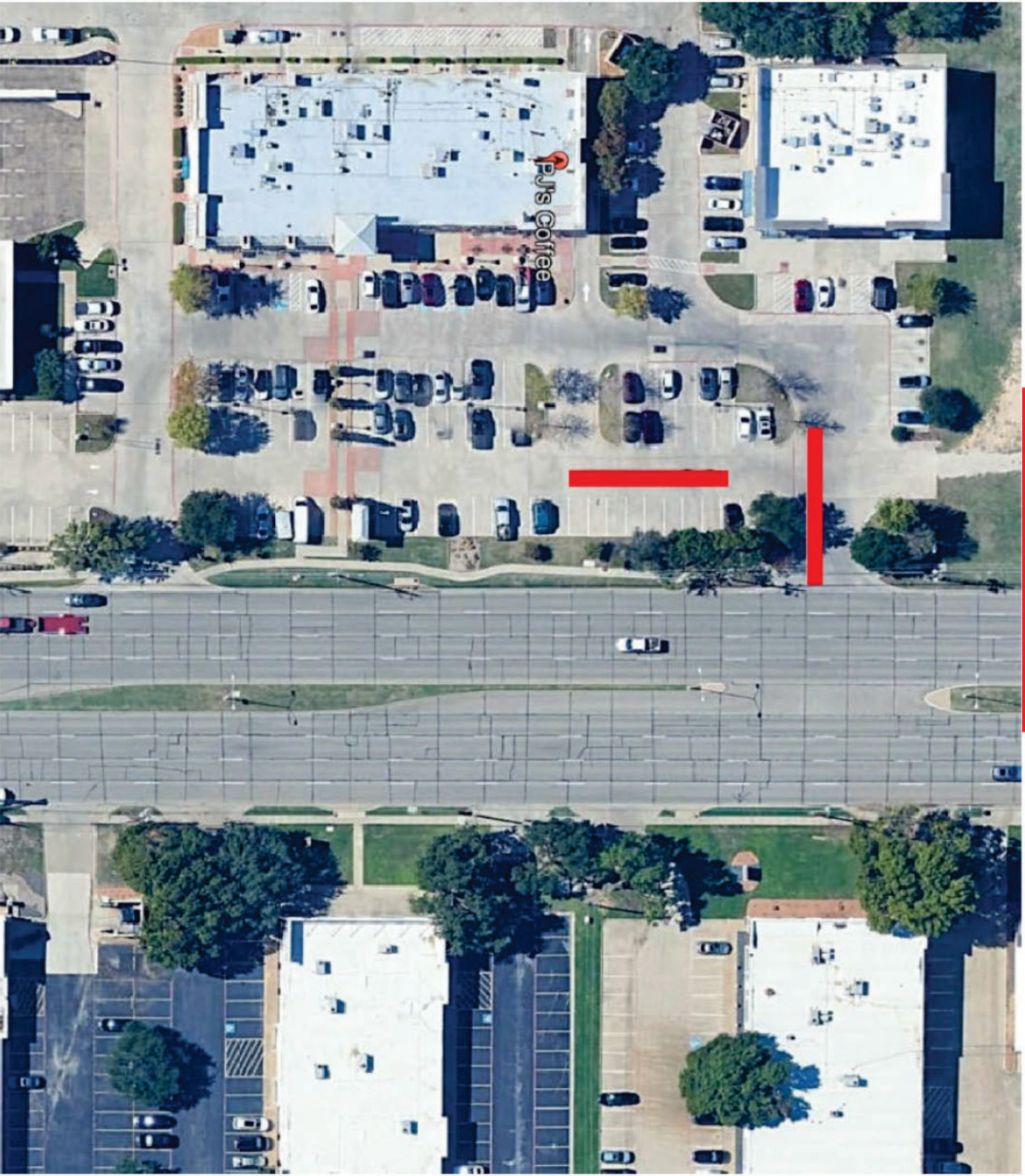

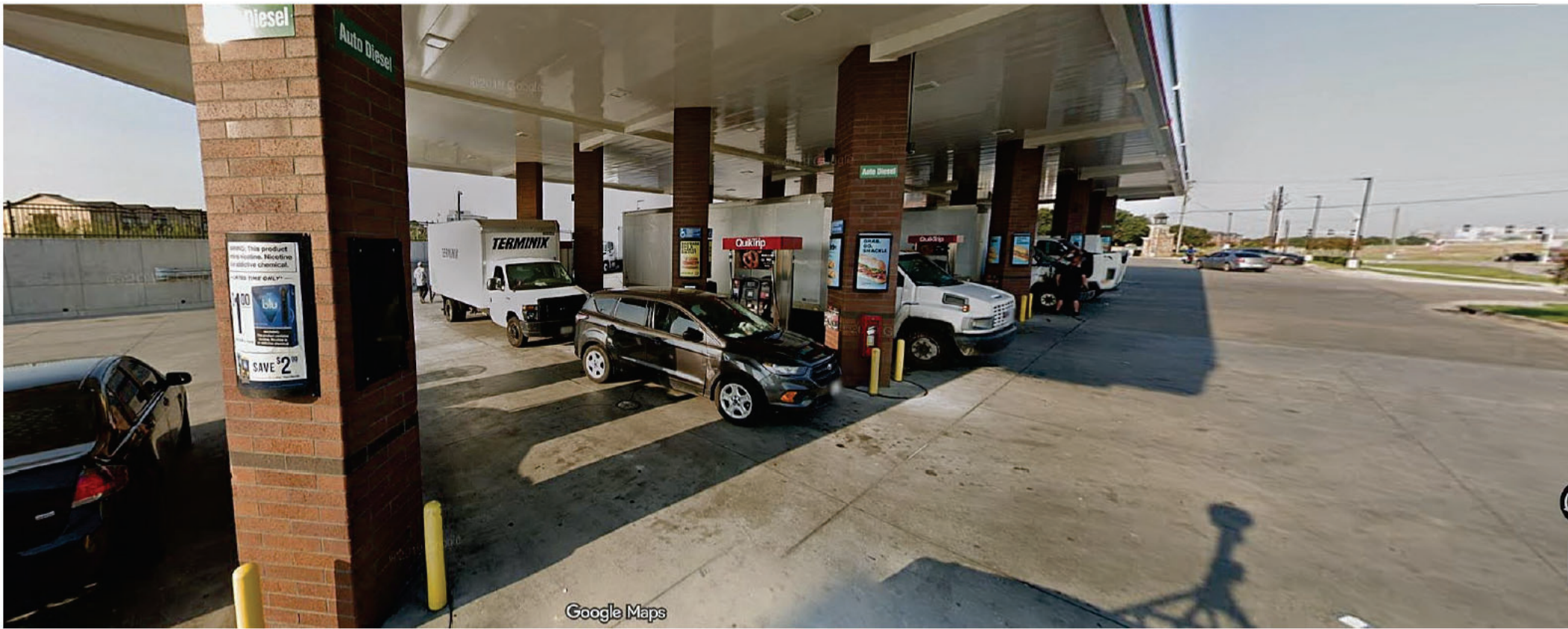

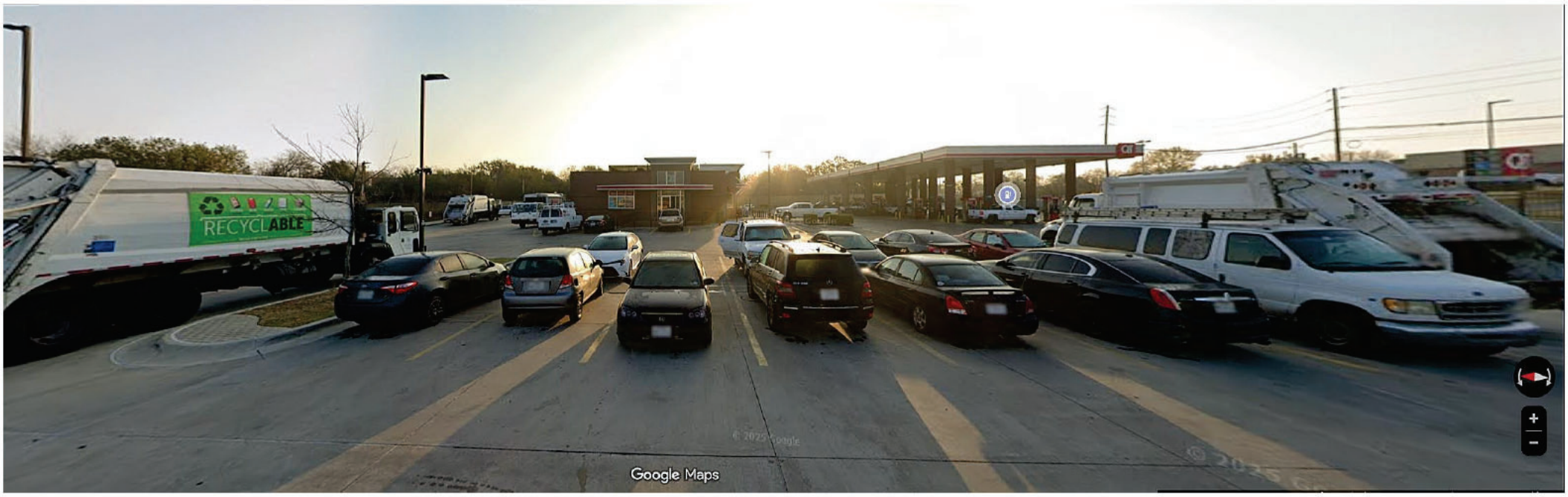

I am writing to request you reject subject case with prejudice. Following is my reasoning:

1. Gasoline stations are aesthetically unattractive with digital display signage, metal structures, lots of concrete, etc. And that's the day they open! Heavy vehicular and pedestrian traffic quickly reduce them to shopworn. There's no such thing as a pleasing gasoline station.
2. It is contrary to the comprehensive plan.
3. This site is not suited for a high traffic use requiring easy in and out. Only southbound Midway traffic has straight forward ingress. Traffic exiting onto Midway is likely to be blocked by cars queuing for the Alpha light and/or will find it difficult to cross the southbound traffic to go north. All traffic must use easements which unreasonably burdens the others owners relying on the easements as well.
4. There's no compelling City revenue case to justify the negatives about the use. 6. Alcohol. The City hasn't availed itself of the opportunity to ban alcohol sales within 1000 feet of a school. It should do that as a separate action. I often see children at the food and coffee places in the retail center next door. Does anyone think they will self regulate and avoid the C store? This by itself is a reason to reject.

Why are we even considering this? The only winner is the property owner. The neighbors, the City, the children, even the transient traffic all lose.

We should be supporting the existing businesses, notably the shopping center owner, and the prominent schools nearby. They are already in the community. Turn it down with prejudice please.

Dear Mayor, Members of the City Council, and Planning Staff,

I am writing as a concerned representative of the property owner in the City of Farmers Branch (13500 Midway) to formally express my opposition to the above-referenced Special Use Permit (SUP) application, Case Number 25-SU-10. This application seeks approval for a QuikTrip gasoline service station and convenience store, including the proposed sale of beer and wine, on approximately 1.48 acres located at 13601 Midway Road within Planned Development District No. 64 (PD-64). After careful consideration of the proposed request and its potential impacts on our community, I respectfully urge the City Council to deny this application.

**Grounds for Opposition**

**1. Incompatibility with Surrounding Land Uses and Neighborhood Character**

The proposed QuikTrip gasoline service station and convenience store is inconsistent with the established character of the surrounding neighborhood and the intent of Planned Development District No. 64 (PD-64). A high-volume fuel and retail operation of this nature — with the associated canopy lighting, fuel delivery trucks, extended or 24-hour operating hours, and constant vehicle activity — is fundamentally out of character with the surrounding area. The 1.48-acre site at 13601 Midway Road is not an appropriate location for this type of commercial use, and approving this SUP would set a damaging precedent that undermines the stability and long-term planning vision the City has established for this district. The proposed development is incompatible with the scale and character of nearby properties and does not align with the goals and objectives of the City's Comprehensive Plan.

## **2. Proposed Beer and Wine Sales Are Detrimental to the Neighborhood**

Of particular concern is QuikTrip's proposal to sell beer and wine at this location. The addition of alcohol sales at a high-traffic gasoline and convenience store on Midway Road would have a direct and negative impact on the surrounding neighborhood. The proximity of alcohol retail to nearby residents, families, and any adjacent schools, parks, or places of worship raises serious concerns about community well-being. The sale of beer and wine at this type of establishment tends to attract loitering, increase litter, and contribute to other nuisance-related activity that diminishes the quality of life for those living nearby. I strongly urge the City Council to consider the cumulative effect that permitting alcohol sales at this location would have on the character and safety of this community, and to deny this component of the application outright.

## **3. Public Safety Concerns**

A gasoline service station and convenience store with alcohol sales at this location raises significant public safety concerns. The combination of fuel storage and dispensing, high vehicle turnover, and the sale of alcoholic beverages creates conditions that warrant serious scrutiny. I am concerned that the application has not adequately addressed the risks associated with this use, including pedestrian safety given the increased vehicle activity at the site, emergency vehicle access, and the broader security implications of a 24-hour or late-night operation that sells alcohol. The safety and well-being of the residents and families in this area must be the City's foremost consideration, and I do not believe those concerns have been sufficiently resolved.

## **Failure to Meet Required SUP Criteria**

For a Special Use Permit to be approved, the application must demonstrate that the proposed use will not be detrimental to the public health, safety, or general welfare; that it is consistent with the City's Comprehensive Plan; and that it is compatible with the character of surrounding uses and the intent of the applicable zoning district. The proposed QuikTrip gasoline service station, convenience store, and beer/wine sales operation at 13601 Midway Road within PD-64 does not satisfy these criteria. Approval of Case Number 25-SU-10 would not be in the best interest of the surrounding community or the City of Farmers Branch as a whole.

I respectfully request that the Planning Department and City Council give serious weight to the concerns raised by the residents and property owners who will be directly impacted by this proposal. I urge you to deny Case Number 25-SU-10 in its entirety and to uphold the standards that protect the integrity, character, and safety of our neighborhood.
