



RESOLUTION NO. 2025-171

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT OF THE CITY'S CYBERSECURITY MONITORING AND VULNERABILITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, WITH ANNUAL PAYMENTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$88,000.00 AND A TOTAL THREE-YEAR PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$264,000.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Farmers Branch's (the "City") cybersecurity monitoring and vulnerability management system safeguards its network infrastructure, systems and data against threats, ensuring the protection of City operations and sensitive information; and

WHEREAS, ongoing support and maintenance of the network infrastructure, systems and data are necessary to ensure the system remains effective, receives regular updates, and provides access to technical expertise for rapid threat detection and response; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends executing a new three-year agreement for the maintenance and support for the City's cybersecurity monitoring and vulnerability management system; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the public interest to approve the recommendation of the City Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Farmers Branch authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute a three-year agreement for the maintenance and support of the City's cybersecurity monitoring and vulnerability management system with annual payments not to exceed \$88,000.00, with total three-year price not to exceed \$264,000.00. The City Manager is further authorized to accept and approve such additional change orders and contract amendments as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, in the public interest, in compliance with applicable law and City policy, and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of funds.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
