The Impact of Healthcare for the Uninsured in Farmers Branch



 Approximately 18% of Farmers Branch residents age 19-64 are uninsured—impacting individual and community health outcomes.

 85% of uninsured adults skip or delay care--leading to more severe conditions, emergency visits, and higher long-term costs.

 Lack of access to screenings and early intervention for chronic conditions like diabetes, hypertension, and obesity increases health risks.

 Vulnerable populations, including low-income families and those facing cultural or language barriers, are most affected.

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 Expanding access to care reduces pressure on ERs and supports long-term community health and cost savings.

 Healthier residents contribute to a stronger workforce and local economy.

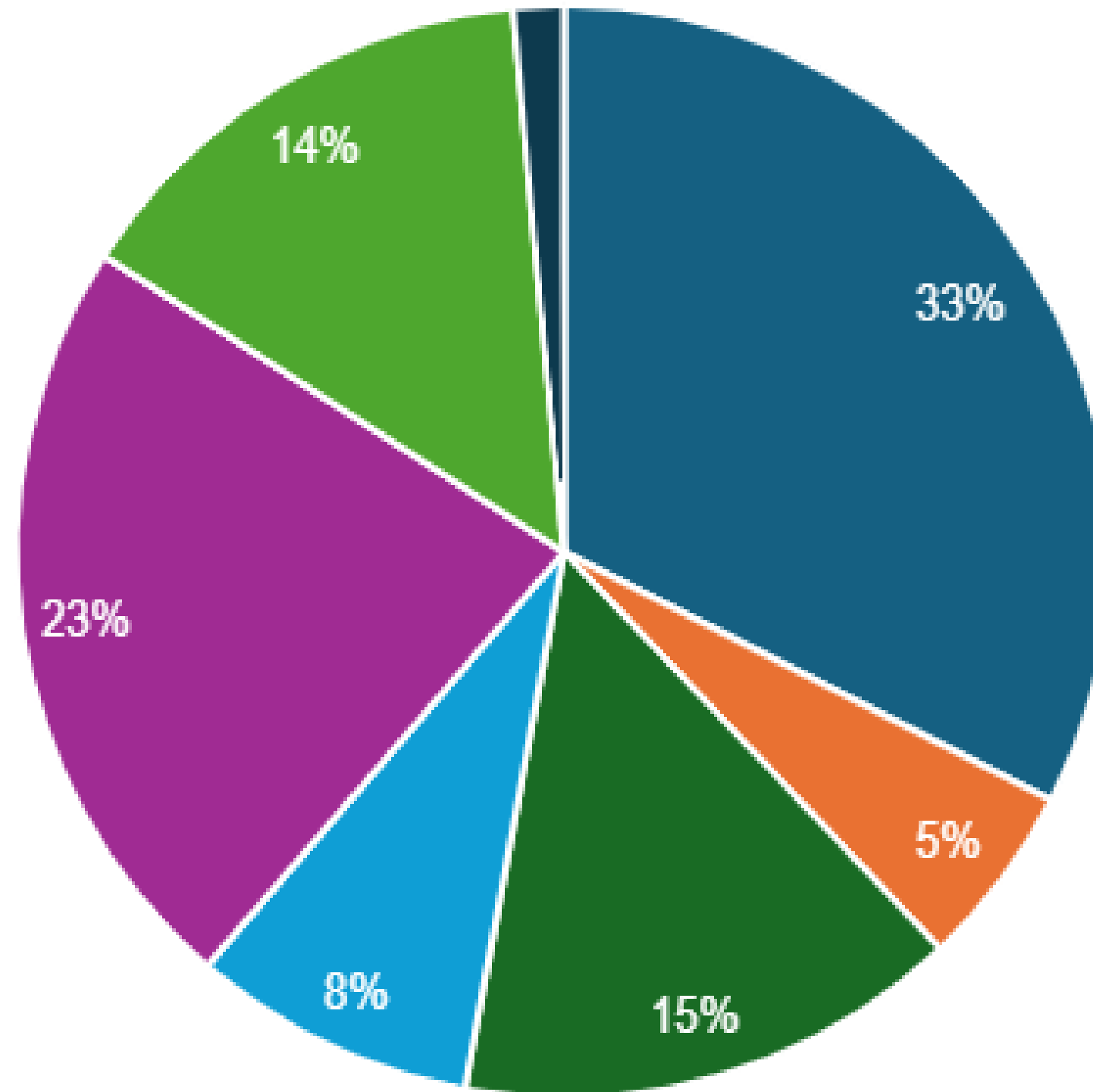
