A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, ACCEPTING THE BID AND AWARDING A UNIT PRICE CONTRACT FOR THE 2026 STREET SECTION REPAIRS TO JIM BOWMAN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, LP, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City Administration, having sought and obtained competitive unit price bids for the construction and installation of the 2026 Street Section Repairs Project (Bid No. 25-20) has determined that Jim Bowman Construction Company, LP, has submitted the lowest unit price bid and recommends a contract to said company; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, finds it to be in the public interest to approve the recommendation of the City Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Farmers Branch does hereby accept the bid and award a contract to Jim Bowman Construction Company, LP, for the construction and installation of the 2025-2026 Street Section Repairs Project and does further authorize the City Manager to sign, on behalf of the City, the Contract with Jim Bowman Construction Company L.P. in accordance with unit prices submitted pursuant to Bid No. 25-20 with an initial term of one year and an option for four (4) renewal terms of one (1) year each, and such change orders to said contract as the City Manager deems reasonable and necessary, and in the public interest which complies with applicable law and City policy and, are subject to the availability of current funds. The City Manager is further authorized to exercise the optional term extensions if he deems it in the public interest, subject to the availability of current funds to pay for the same.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
