Solution: Rescind \$10 Base Rate Fee reduction No increase in variable water rate

UTILITY REHAB AND REPLACEMENT

- I23 Miles of pre-I980 non-PVC
 Water Main
- Estimated Cost = \$200M
- Extended Replacement Program





WASTEWATER: INFLOW AND INFILTRATION

- Capital Improvement Project Locations, top five projects -
 - Estimated at \$1,500,000
- 25 additional wastewater projects identified on the CIP list -
 - Estimated at \$11,100,000
- Approx. 498,000 feet of non-pvc wastewater piping left in the city
 - 458,000 of which is clay tile
- Estimated cost to replace the remaining clay tile mains
 - \$128M+





- Ten-year project for replacement of battery backups and relamping of 6 intersections per year
 - Estimated at \$140,000/yr.
- Valley View from Denton Dr. to Josey Ln.- multi-phase project funded through
 - RTC \$1,400,000 grant and Street Revitalization CIP if needed
- Pike St. and Denton Dr.- Design and Reconstruction-
 - \$3,400,000 from Pike St. Bond
- Capital Improvement Project Locations 8 street rehab projects identified for 2023-2024 –
 - Estimated at \$2,300,000

Reach 4 - (2963 Sunbeck, 2971 Sunbeck, 12407 Treeview,
 12411 Treeview)

Valley View at Rawhide Bridge

Rockmartin at FB Creek Sewer Main Protection

Rawhide Creek (Valley View to Webb Chapel) –

Estimated at \$3,000,000 for all 3 phases

- Ford Rd (East of FB Creek Bridge)
 - Estimated at \$350,000
- Reach 2 (FB Creek @ Lost Valley)
 - Estimated at \$800,000





SUSTAINABILITY: PEDESTRIAN CONNECTIVITY

 Westside Art Trail from Campion Trail to Mercer Parkway and from Emerald Street to Denton Drive – Congestion, Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ)

Funding Amount: \$4,545,725 - The City is using TDCs for the local match.

Bee Street Sidewalk Expansion Completion: - Trail Bond Fund for design and construction:

\$460,700 (construction) and \$57,600 for design

Valley View Lane/Mercer Parkway pedestrian crossing: Applying for Transportation Alternative
 Grant through NCTCOG for construction:

Construction Cost: \$750,000 Design: \$110,000
