



RESOLUTION NO. 2026-062

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS, THE CITY OF ADDISON, THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, AND THE CITY OF COPPELL TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$130,000 FOR COORDINATED DISASTER DEBRIS MANAGEMENT PLANNING AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COORDINATED DISASTER DEBRIS MANAGEMENT PLAN; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT ON THE CITY'S BEHALF, TO IMPLEMENT THE CITY'S OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT, AND TO EXECUTE AND APPROVE SUCH INSTRUMENTS AND AMENDMENTS AS MAY BE REASONABLE AND NECESSARY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has been asked to participate in the negotiation and creation of an integrated disaster debris management plan by and among the City and the cities of Addison, Carrollton, and Coppel; and

WHEREAS, the North Central Texas Council of Governments has offered to provide grant funding in the amount of \$130,000 to the City in exchange for its participation in and integrated coordination of disaster debris management plans among all cities; and

WHEREAS, the grand funding involves the collaborative development of individual disaster debris management plans by each city that should be interdependent due to the high level of coordination to ensure seamless integration and mutual support during disaster response and recovery efforts; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas finds it to be in the public interest and in the interests of public health and safety to participate in the development of an integrated disaster debris management plan and enter into the interlocal agreement with the North Central Texas Council of Governments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council accepts and approves the interlocal agreement by and between the City of Farmers Branch and the North Central Texas Council of Governments, the City of Addison, the City of Carrollton, and the City of Coppel for the negotiation and development of an integrated disaster debris management plan, and to accept a grant from the North Central Texas Council of Governments in the amount of \$130,000 in reimbursements for participation, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 2. The City Council further authorizes the City Manager to sign the interlocal agreement on behalf of the City, to implement the provisions of the interlocal agreement, and to approve and execute such instruments and amendments as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, and in the public interest, which are in compliance with applicable law and City policy.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
