Community Run Event and 2026 Special Events

Background

- 1** As part of a Future Agenda item at the October 21, 2025, Council Meeting, Mayor Pro Tem Tina Bennett-Burton requested that staff put forth information on a Community Run event for Council review.
- 2** Staff contacted the run event vendor AMPT on run logistics for a future event.
- 3** Staff met with FBPD, FBFD staff on run event logistics.
- 4** Staff will review community run event logistics and its impact on 2026 Special Events.



Community Run Event proposal:

- Proposed Date: Saturday, October 10, 2026.
- Race would begin at 8am.
- Event would be a 5K run and walk event on a certified USTAF course.
- Proposed location: Race begins and ends in the Historical Park.
- Proposed race route will be in the neighborhoods around the Historical Park.
- Race will be the start of Halloween and costume theme community event to follow race.
- The event following the race will be a festival atmosphere.
- Utilize typical Special Event logistics for the Historical Park i.e. parking and event layout
