A. CALL TO ORDER (6 P.M.)

Mayor Lynne called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

B. EXECUTIVE SESSION

B.1 City Council will convene into closed executive session pursuant to Section 551.074 Personnel Deliberation and Section 551.071 (2) of the Texas Government Code to discuss and review a Code of Ethics complaint against Mayor Terry Lynne and receive a report from the City Attorney regarding said complaint.

The City Council convened into Executive Session at 6:00 p.m.

C. TAKE ANY ACTION AS A RESULT OF THE CLOSED EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mayor Pro Tem Jackson reconvened the City Council from Executive Session at 8:58 p.m. the following action was taken.
