



RESOLUTION NO. 2025-172

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE, EXECUTE, AND AMEND A THREE-YEAR ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT WITH A SOFTWARE VENDOR FOR LICENSING AND CLOUD SERVICES WITH ANNUAL PAYMENTS NOT TO EXCEED \$290,000 PER YEAR AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the current agreement providing access to enterprise-level software tools and services is set to expire October 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, these tools include emails, document management, collaboration tools, cloud-based services, endpoint management, and licensing; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends executing a new three-year enterprise agreement with a software vendor for the City's core productivity and infrastructure software platforms, covering essential services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the public interest to approve the recommendation of the City Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Farmers Branch authorizes the City Manager to negotiate, execute, and amend a three-year enterprise agreement for software licensing and cloud services with a software vendor with annual payments not to exceed \$290,000 per year. The City Manager is further authorized to accept and approve such additional change orders and contract amendments as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, in the public interest, in compliance with applicable law and City policy, and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of funds.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
