Citizens Collection Station

History

- Originally opened in 2003
- Closed in 2009
- Reopened in 2013
- Temporarily closed in 2024
- Final closure 2025

2025 Budget

- Site closed following budget discussions beginning FY 2025
 - FTE and operational expenses
- Budget will be added to FY 2026 beginning October 2025.

Regulations

Definition: facility established for the convenience and exclusive use of residents...


Permit type: Notification

Notification requirements: At least 90 days prior to opening, and operational narrative

Proposed Location

- 13333 Senlac Drive
- Saturday only
- Require unbudgeted OT for Brush and Bulk staff
- Entire operational areas needs to be fenced
- Takes away from staff
 parking





Household Hazardous Waste

History

- City pays Dallas County for HHW services
- Began hosting events in FB around 2010
- One event per year
- Sites: Oran Good Park parking lot and 13333 Senlac Drive

2025 Budget

- Disposal at Dallas County Site: \$21,000
- Disposal for Farmers Branch HHW event: \$22,000
- Setup cost for Farmers Branch event: \$1,500

Regulations

Texas has a residential exemption for HHW disposal at a Type I landfill

• Dallas County handles the permitting for the HHW events Usage

- Event usage has been steady to declining over the past few years
- 100-150 patrons per event
