



RESOLUTION NO. 2024-199

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT WITH THE MOTOR VEHICLE CRIME PREVENTION AUTHORITY UNDER THE CATALYTIC CONVERTER GRANT PROGRAM TO OBTAIN FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES FOR ECONOMIC MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT, INCLUDING CATALYTIC CONVERTER THEFT; DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER AS THE AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL, AND CERTAIN PERSONNEL AS PROGRAM DIRECTOR AND PROGRAM FINANCE OFFICER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Texas Transportation Code Chapter 1006 and Texas Administrative Code Title 43; Part 3; Chapter 57, entities are eligible to receive grants from the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority to provide financial support to law enforcement taskforces and agencies for economic motor vehicle theft, including catalytic converter theft; and

WHEREAS, participating in this grant program will assist this jurisdiction to combat catalytic converter theft; and

WHEREAS, the City of Farmers Branch has agreed to comply with the grant that funding requirements and in the event of loss or misuse of the grant funds, the City of Farmers Branch agrees and assures that the grant funds will be returned in full to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch finds it to be in the public interest to participate in the grant program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and ordered that the City Manager is designated as the Authorized Official to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority Grant Program and to execute all other necessary documents to accept said grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Addison Holmes, Grants Coordinator, is designated as the Program Director and Tammy Zimmerman, Director of Finance, Fleet and Facilities, is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective and shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of passage as the law and Charter in such cases provide.
