Ordinance Objectives

Regulate oversized and commercial vehicles in residentially zoned areas

Reduction of weight on residential streets to reduce damage to the streets

Enforce similar to our peer municipalities

Reduces overcrowding of vehicles on residential streets

Improve the livability of the residents and the neighborhood



Current Ordinance

Ambiguous provisions exist that regulate the parking of Oversized Vehicles in residential areas.

Proposed Ordinance

- Vehicle and Oversized Vehicle Defined
- Prohibits RVs, boats, box trucks, dump trucks, tow trucks, trailers, vehicles in excess of 8 feet in width or 21 feet in length.
- Prohibits oversized vehicle in a residential district
- Prohibits parking/storing vehicle in rear or side yard unless concealed from right-of-way by:
 - Permitted wall/fence
 - Landscaping, or
 - o Combination of the above
- Provides 18-month Grace Period

As proposed, does not impact H.B. 2464. (No-Impact Home-Based Businesses)
