

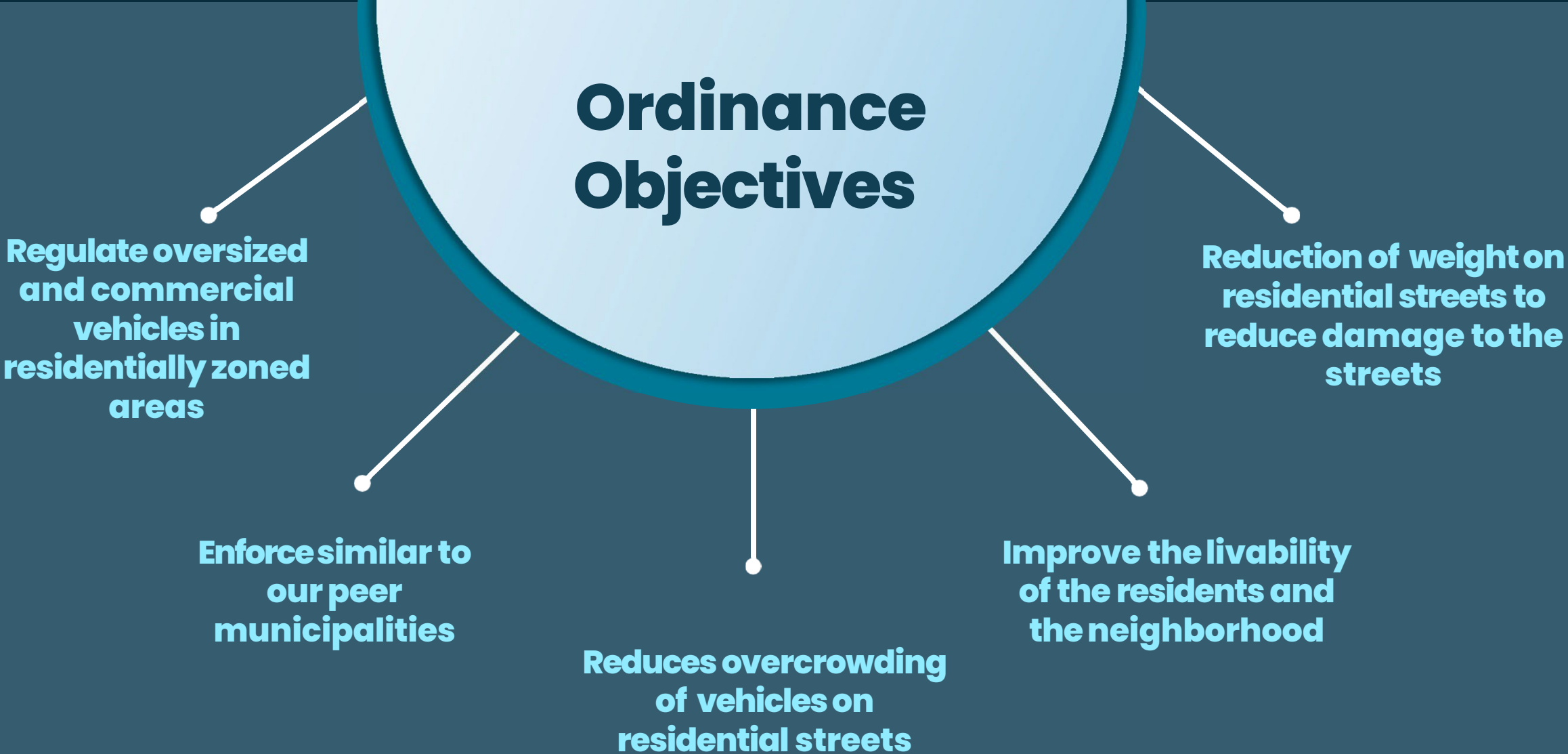


Oversized Vehicle Regulations

Ordinance Objectives



**Regulate oversized
and commercial
vehicles in
residentially zoned
areas**

**Reduction of weight on
residential streets to
reduce damage to the
streets**

**Improve the livability
of the residents and
the neighborhood**

**Reduces overcrowding
of vehicles on
residential streets**

**Enforces similar to
our peer
municipalities**



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Current Ordinance

Ambiguous provisions exist that regulate the parking of Oversized Vehicles in residential areas.

Proposed Ordinance

- Vehicle and Oversized Vehicle Defined
- Prohibits RVs, boats, box trucks, dump trucks, tow trucks, trailers, vehicles in excess of 8 feet in width or 21 feet in length.
- Prohibits oversized vehicle in a residential district
- Prohibits parking/storing vehicle in rear or side yard unless concealed from right-of-way by:
 - Permitted wall/fence
 - Landscaping, or
 - Combination of the above
- Provides 18-month Grace Period

As proposed, does not impact H.B. 2464.
(No-Impact Home-Based Businesses)
