



RESOLUTION NO. 2026-093

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, ADOPTING AND APPROVING A REVISED PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT POLICY ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT “A”; PROVIDING THAT FURTHER AMENDMENTS MAY BE AFFECTED BY CITY STAFF; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City staff has adopted and implemented a policy setting forth guidelines to ensure prompt responses to requests for information under the Texas Public Information Act, Chapter 552, Texas Government Code, and to recover partial costs associated with the time and expense of responding; and

WHEREAS, the proposed revision to the policy, which requires approval of the City’s governing body, reduces the time and expense associated with responding to repetitive requests under the Act; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the policy revisions are in the best interest of the citizens of the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City’s revised Public Information Act Policy, attached as Exhibit “A”, is hereby approved and adopted and is to be followed from and after the effective date of this Resolution. Future revisions to said Policy may be adopted and implemented by City staff, without the need for further formal Council action unless otherwise required by law.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
