

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-193

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, APPROVING THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE EIGHT GENERIC MANUFACTURERS STATEWIDE OPIOID SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SUCH SUBDIVISION ELECTION AND RELEASE FORMS AND OTHER DOCUMENTS AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE TEXAS ATTORNEY GENERAL IN CONNECTION WITH THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN SAID SETTLEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Texas and its communities, including the City of Farmers Branch (the "City"), have been harmed through the epidemic caused by the sale, use, and distribution of opioids within the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City has been provided with information indicating that certain drug companies and their corporate affiliates, parents, subsidiaries, and such other defendants as may be added to the litigation (collectively, "Defendants") have engaged in fraudulent and/or reckless marketing and/or distribution of opioids that have resulted in addictions, overdoses, and death to many Texans; and

WHEREAS, these actions, conduct and misconduct have resulted in significant financial costs to the City, County and State; and

WHEREAS, the State of Texas, through the Office of the Attorney General, entered into settlement agreements with eight generic manufacturers Alvogen, Amneal, Apotex, Hikma, Indivior, Mylan, Sun, and Zydus (the "Eight Generic Manufacturers Settlements"), providing a settlement of claims against both to compensate the State of Texas and participating political subdivisions for the effects of their actions that contributed to the opioid epidemic; and

WHEREAS, in order to participate in the Eight Generic Manufacturers Settlements, the City must approve and execute a Texas Settlement Subdivision Participation Form; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the City to authorize the execution of the Texas Settlement Subdivision Participation Form to allow the City to participate in the Eight Generic Manufacturers Settlements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council supports the participation in these settlements and authorizes the City Manager to execute the Texas Settlement Subdivision Participation Form, and such other settlement documents as may be requested by the Texas Attorney General's Office, in

connection with the City's participation in the Eight Generic Manufacturers Settlement.

SECTION 2. That the City Council finds that there is a need for repayment of opioid-related expenditures and payment to abate opioid-related harms in and about the City of Farmers Branch.

SECTION 3. The recitals contained herein are found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Resolution for all purposes.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
