A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF NEW CAMERAS AT THE CITY'S JAIL IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$49,990.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to purchase additional cameras for the City's jail that will integrate with the existing video system to provide clearer images and expanded visibility, ensuring consistent coverage and increased safety; and

WHEREAS, City Administration has proposed authorizing an agreement for the purchase of new cameras at the City's jail through the State's DIR cooperative program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas finds it to be in the public interest to approve the recommendation of the City Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Farmers Branch hereby authorizes an agreement for the purchase of additional cameras for the City's jail through the State's DIR cooperative program, in an amount not to exceed \$49,990.00, and does further authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute on behalf of the City all necessary contract documents and, subject to available funding, to execute any change orders, renewal options, amendments, or other instruments related thereto.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
