






25-SP-01 and 25-SU-03 Aerial Map 1801 Valley View Lane

#### A. STUDY SESSION (6:30 PM)

#### A.1 <u>25-79</u> Discuss Regular Agenda Items.

Chair Raley asked for any questions or comments regarding the Regular Agenda and Public Hearing items.

Regarding Item D.1, Mr. Mangum answered questions from the Commissioners regarding: clarification on the proposed outdoor storage; whether the applicant would utilize the existing parking spaces for the outdoor storage; whether any improvements to the site were proposed; whether the outdoor storage would be screened by fencing; and whether the applicant had completed a Traffic Impact Analysis (TIA).

### D. PUBLIC HEARING

#### D.1 25-SU-03

Conduct a public hearing and consider the request for a Specific Use Permit – Interim Use for outside storage at 1801 Valley View Lane located within the Planned Development District No. 77 (PD-77) zoning district; and take appropriate action.

Mr. Mangum gave a presentation regarding the Specific Use Permit (SUP) request.

Mr. Mangum answered questions from Commissioners regarding: whether the existing property was a flat lot with no fencing; and whether the vehicles would be subject to towing from the Police Department.

Hearing no further questions or comments from the Commissioners, Chair Raley opened the public hearing. No one came forward to address this agenda item.

A motion was made by Vice-Chair Miller, seconded by Commissioner Trapp, that the public hearing be closed. The motion carried unanimously.
