



RESOLUTION NO. 2020-052

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH LOCKWOOD, ANDREWS, & NEWNAM, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR DESIGN OF FB CREEK EROSION REPAIR REACH 2; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City Administration has determined that improvements to the erosion issues of Farmers Branch Creek are necessary for the protection of City facilities and adjacent properties ("FB Creek Erosion Repair Reach 2" or "the Project"); and

WHEREAS, City Administration, having determined that the firm of Lockwood, Andrews & Newnam, Inc. is qualified to perform the professional engineering services necessary for the preparation of plans and specifications relating to the bidding and construction of the Project, recommends negotiating an agreement with Lockwood, Andrews & Newnam, Inc. to provide such professional engineering services pursuant to cost for such services that are fair and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, finds it to be in the public interest to concur in the above recommendation.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and sign on behalf of the City an agreement with Lockwood, Andrews & Newnam, Inc. in the amount of \$147,509.00 for engineering services related to the preparation of plans and specifications for the Project.


SECTION 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon approval.


