This is a request for the Park Board to review two proposed schematic plans for the Squire Park redevelopment.

Background:

Staff has obtained design services to develop concept plans based on feedback gathered through the Squire Park public outreach program and input from various City of Farmers Branch stakeholders.

The vision for the park redevelopment is to update the amenities and improve spatial utilization while maintaining its character as a neighborhood park for the immediate residents who currently use it.

The proposed schematic designs address the following goals:

- Preserve the park's character
- Improve Park circulation
- Incorporate parking management strategies
- Enhance safety measures
- Preserve the mature tree canopy and introduce vegetation buffers
- Define Park boundaries

- Introducing additional amenities such as racquet sports

You will find two proposed schematic plans in the packet for your review. Please note that these plans are intended as a starting point and can be adjusted based on feedback from the Park Board.

Staff request that, prior to the February 19th meeting, the concept plans be reviewed and feedback provided at the meeting. This input will help staff refine the plans for consideration by the City Council as the next step in the review process.
