RESOLUTION NO. 2025-160



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE PROPERTY TAX INCREASE REFLECTED IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 BUDGET; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code §102.007(c) requires that adoption of a budget that raises more property tax revenue than was generated the previous year requires a record vote of the City Council to ratify the property tax increase reflected in the budget in addition to and separate from the record votes to approve the ordinance adopting the annual budget and the ordinance adopting the tax rate for the current tax year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved Ordinance No. 3958 amending the Fiscal Year 2024-25 Operating and Capital Improvement Program Budget and establishing and adopting the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget, which will raise more revenue from property taxes than last year's budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, desires to ratify the property tax increase reflected in Ordinance No. 3958.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The property tax increase reflected in the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Operating and Capital Improvement Program Budget and approved pursuant to Ordinance No. 3958 is hereby ratified.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
