



ORDINANCE NO. 3988

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, TO AMEND SECTION 82-95(b) OF DIVISION 6 “PARKING” OF ARTICLE II “OPERATION OF VEHICLES” OF CHAPTER 82 “TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES” BY ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON KNIGHTSBRIDGE ROAD FROM LUNA ROAD TO CROWN DRIVE AND REQUIRING APPROPRIATE SIGNAGE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Administration, in order to increase the safety of the movement of traffic along the public thoroughfares of the City of Farmers Branch, has recommended the establishment of a certain no parking zone along Knightsbridge Road, between Luna Road and Crown Drive; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, finds it to be in the public interest and in the interest of public health and safety to amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Farmers Branch to establish the recommended no parking zone.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, is hereby amended by amending subsection (b) of Section 82-95 (“No Parking Zones”) of Division 6 (“Parking”) of Article II (“Operation of Vehicles”) of Chapter 82 (“Traffic and Vehicles”) to establish a no parking zone on Knightsbridge Road, adding an entry in the table in subsection (b) between the entries for Keenan Bridge Road and Lago Vista East, as follows:

Street:	Description	Time of Day

Knightsbridge Road	Both sides, from its intersection with Luna Road to the intersection of Crown Drive	All times
...

SECTION 2. Appropriate signs prohibiting parking at the places and during the times consistent with this Ordinance shall be maintained by the City, and the prohibition contained in this ordinance shall not be enforced unless such signage is posted.

SECTION 3. All provisions of the ordinances and resolutions of the City of Farmers Branch in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed, and all other provisions of the ordinances and resolutions of the City not in conflict with the provisions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. An offense committed before the effective date of this ordinance is governed by prior law, and the provisions of the Code of Ordinances, as amended, in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for this purpose.

SECTION 5. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance shall be judged to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof other than the portion so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 6. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined a sum not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, and the publication of the caption of said ordinance as the law and the City Charter in such cases provide.
