



Nominations for DCAD Board of Directors

Requested By: Administrative Services Department

Background

- The Texas Property Tax Code provides that an appraisal district be governed by a board of nine directors comprised of both appointed and elected directors.
- Two directors' terms (Place 4 and Place 5) will expire December 31, 2025. DCAD is seeking nominees for these positions. The directors elected will serve a 4-year term from January 2026 to December 2029.
- A ballot will be created with the nominees from all taxing units and will be sent out to the governing bodies for their votes. The City of Farmers Branch is entitled to 14 votes, seven per director appointment.

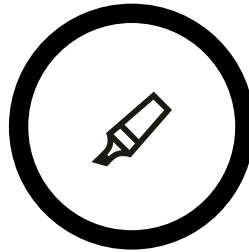

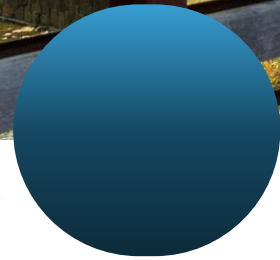

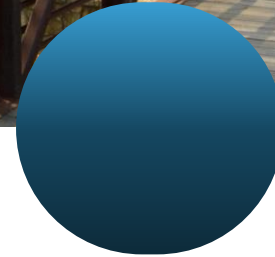

OPTION 1

Council selects one or more nominees to be placed on the ballot for the DCAD Board of Directors election.
