



RESOLUTION NO. 2025-184

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, ACCEPTING THE BID AND AWARDING A UNIT PRICE CONTRACT FOR THE FY25-26 UTILITIES SUPPLY BID TO FERGUSON WATERWORKS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Utilities Division of the City's Public Works Department solicits bids annually for the purchase of various materials to stock for day-to-day operations and after-hours emergencies; and

WHEREAS, City staff solicited bids for the purchase of materials for the City's Utilities Division for the FY25-26 budget year and, upon review of the bids received, found that Ferguson Waterworks submitted the most complete and cost-effective bid; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch finds it in the public interest to authorize the foregoing purchase of materials as recommended by City staff and authorizes the City Manager to execute such purchase orders and other documents necessary to effectuate the purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Farmers Branch does hereby accept the bid and award a unit price contract to Ferguson Waterworks for the purchase of materials for the Utilities Division of Public Works, pursuant to the purchase documents attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and is further authorized to execute any necessary or appropriate documents and approve such amendments thereto as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, in the public interest, and in compliance with applicable law and City policy, and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of funds.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its approval.
