

# **New In-House Model**

In March 2025, Transitioned from a single-vendor model to a fully in-house parts model.

Provides Significant Long-term cost savings and greater inventory control.

This resolution authorizes using multiple cooperative agreements instead of a single vendor.

Ensures best value, availability, and full compliance with Texas procurement law.
