



RESOLUTION NO. 2026-012

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF SOFTWARE LICENSING, SUPPORT, AND MAINTENANCE FOR THE CITY'S VIRTUAL SERVER ENVIRONMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE AGREEMENTS AND PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT ON THE CITY'S BEHALF; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City staff has determined, and the City Council concurs, that it is necessary to renew the annual software licensing, support, and maintenance services that support the City's virtual server environment; and

WHEREAS, this virtual server environment is used to operate essential technology systems that support daily municipal operations across multiple City departments; and

WHEREAS, the proposed renewal provides continued software licensing, customer support, and system maintenance services necessary to ensure the reliability and availability of these systems; and

WHEREAS, the proposed renewal provides continued licensing, technical support, and system maintenance services necessary to maintain City operations during Fiscal Year 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch finds it to be in the public interest to authorize such renewal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Farmers Branch hereby affirms the renewal of software licensing, support, and maintenance services for the City's virtual server environment in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 and does further authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute on behalf of the City all necessary contract documents and, subject to available funding, to execute any change orders, renewal options, amendments, or other instruments related thereto.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
