

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-040



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, REAFFIRMING, APPROVING AND RATIFYING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH FREESE AND NICHOLS, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$69,220 FOR THE US ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY'S AMERICA'S WATER INFRASTRUCTURE ACT (EPA AWIA) 5-YEAR RECERTIFICATION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE AGREEMENTS AND PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT ON THE CITY'S BEHALF; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, and Freese & Nichols, Inc., have negotiated a Professional Services Agreement for the US Environmental Protection Agency's America's Water Infrastructure Act/Safe Drinking Water Act 5-year recertification (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, City Administration recommends approval of the ratification of the professional services agreement with Freese & Nichols, Inc., for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, upon full review and consideration of the proposed professional services agreement and all matters related thereto, is of the opinion and finds that the professional services agreement should be accepted, reaffirmed and ratified and that the City Manager or designee, should be authorized to accept and accomplish the procurement described therein, which the Council finds and determines are in the best interests of the citizens of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Council approves, reaffirms and ratifies the professional services agreement with Freese & Nichols, Inc., for professional services in connection with the US Environmental Protection Agency's America's Water Infrastructure Act/Safe Drinking Water Act 5-year recertification, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A," in an amount not to exceed \$69,220, and further authorizes the City Manager to accept and approve the agreement, to execute the agreement on the City's behalf, to provide for payment thereon, and to accept and approve such contract amendments as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, in the public interest, in compliance with applicable law and City policy, and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of funds.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage as the law and charter in such cases provide.
