Sister City Program

Sister cities are a form of legal or social agreement between towns or cities in geographically and politically distinct areas to promote cultural and commercial ties. These programs create opportunities for citizens and city officials to experience, explore, and learn from other cultures.

Dallas County Public Health Advisory Comm

The committee prioritizes various health issues county residents face and is also charged with coordinating efforts of all participating entities to improve the health of county citizens.

Trinity River Authority

The Trinity River Authority's mission is to promote the conservation, protection, and development of the river basin's natural resources for the public's benefit. Beginning in February, meetings are held on the last Wednesday of every other month at 10 a.m.

North Texas Commission

The North Texas Commission is a public-private partnership focused on advancing the vitality of the North Texas region. Members steer policymaking decisions and advocate for legislation through a variety of committees, task forces, and industry councils. Meetings are held on the third Thursday at 3:00 p.m. in February, May, September, and November.
