


CBO1 – Adopt a City-Wide Comprehensive Plan

- The full process will span 15-18 months with three distinct public engagement phases:








Comprehensive Plan Community Visioning Workshop

CBO3 & CBO7 – Enhance Landscape Regulations and Develop Tree Preservation Ordinance

City Council adopted Strategic Plan 2022, which directed the following

- ► CBO3 Identify and implement a solution for managing drainage and retention
- ► CBO7 Execute sustainability initiatives

Both council initiatives and current Planning and Zoning Commission Workplan includes update and creation of enhanced landscape regulations and tree preservation requirements.

Staff is actively working on both ordinance amendment processes.
