

ARTICLE II. BOARDS, COMMITTEES, AND COMMISSIONSⁱ

DIVISION 1. GENERALLY

Sec. 2-31. Removal of certain board or commission members by city council; absences.

- (a) Except as otherwise provided in this Code or state law, the city council may remove members of board and commissions as provided in section 2.09 of the City Charter.
- (b) Any person appointed by the City Council to a board or commission as either a regular member or alternate member, in which the board or commission convenes fewer than eight meetings per year, shall be deemed to have resigned and vacated the position to which such person was appointed if such person is absent from more than 50 percent of the regular meetings of the board or commission during any period of 12 consecutive months. Any person appointed by the City Council to a board or commission as either a regular member or alternate member, in which the board or commission convenes eight or more meetings per year, shall be deemed to have resigned and vacated the position to which such person was appointed if such person is absent from more than 25 percent of the regular meetings of the board or commission during any period of 12 consecutive months.
- (c) The vacancy created by the resignation deemed to have occurred pursuant to the application of section 2-31(b) shall be effective upon adjournment of the regular meeting the absence from which resulted in the person's resignation.
- (d) Not later than ten days after each regular meeting of a board or commission, the chairperson of each board and commission shall report any absences of regular and alternate members from such meeting to the city secretary.
