I. PUBLIC HEARING

I.2 23-ZA-06

Conduct a public hearing and consider the request to amend the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance related to garage conversions and adopting applicable regulations including but not limited to amending: Article 4. "Site Development Standards" Section 4.3 "Parking and Loading" Subsection K "Carports and Garages" by amending paragraph 3 relating to garage conversions and adding paragraph 5 titled "Amnesty Program Permit"; and take appropriate action.

Mr. Campbell gave a presentation regarding the proposed amendment. Ms. Summers answered questions.

After some discussion, Chair Raley opened the public hearing.

Mr. Patrick Beal, 2655 Mount View Drive, Farmers Branch, and Ms. Jan Myers, 3530 Pinehurst Circle, Farmers Branch, asked questions regarding the amendment.

No one else came forward to address this agenda item. Chair Raley asked for a motion to close the public hearing.

A motion was made by Commissioner Miller, seconded by Commissioner Froehlich that the public hearing be closed. The motion carried unanimously.

- That re-inspection fees currently listed in Appendix A be clarified.
