2024 Water Conservation Plan

CITY COUNCIL MEETING | April 16, 2024



A water conservation plan is required by the State of Texas for communities which provide water service to 3,300 or more connections.

Plan must be submitted to Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) by May 1, as well as to the appropriate regional water planning group.

Water conservation plans must be updated every 5 years. Last update was May 2019.





Plans must include a utility profile which provides an overview of the system, as well as water use data for the previous 5 years.

Plan includes 5 and 10 year targets for water use in gallons per capita per day (gpcd) for total water use, residential water use, and water loss.





Other plan requirements are:

- **Universal metering of both customer and public uses of water,**
- **Meter testing, repair and periodic replacement,**
- **A rate structure which does not encourage excessive water use, and**
- **Leak detection and repair.**
