




## Samsara 12 Month Review

# Background

- 1 A five-year contract with Samsara was approved by Resolution No. 2024-180 on October 22, 2025
- 2 Year 1 = \$30,209  
Years 2-5 = \$64,786 per year
- 3 330 assets are tracked by Samsara.  
\$14.61 per asset per month average
- 4 An initial review was requested to justify the increase in years two through five

# How we are using it



## Users in the system

Users from Police, Fire, Public Works, Community Services, and Parks Departments are using the system to improve their operations.

## Vehicle and Equipment Location

Tracking the location and data from 220 vehicles, 50 trailers, and other equipment, and are gathering useful data for decision-making.

## Fleet Data

Mileage, engine hours, and sensor data are integrated into our Fleet Information System and are critical for being proactive on maintenance and repairs.

## Alerts

Alerts for fault codes, vehicle sensor data, medic temperatures, emergency light, and generator status give us advanced warning of potential issues in the fleet.

Samsara has been evolving as we continue to implement the program throughout the fleet.



### Baseline Data

With the first year's worth of data, we have set a baseline to compare our progress



### Reduce Idle Time

Decrease fuel consumption, fleet costs, and wear on equipment



### Driver Safety

Leverage the platform to foster safer driving through driver safety program



### Fleet Utilization

Continue to monitor vehicle usage data throughout the fleet.
