- WHEREAS, home fires kill more than 2,500 people annually in the United; and
- WHEREAS, three out of five home deaths result from fires in properties without working smoke alarms; and
- WHEREAS, working smoke alarms cut the risk of dying in home fires in half; and
- WHEREAS, residents should ensure that their smoke alarms are in working order by testing them monthly, changing the battery at least once a year, making sure they are properly located and replacing them every 10 years; and
- WHEREAS, the Farmers Branch Fire Department is dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires through prevention education; and
- WHEREAS, the 2014 Fire Prevention Month theme, "Smoke Alarms Save Lives!" effectively serves to remind reminds us if a fire occurs, we need working smoke alarms to give us the time needed to get out safely.
