



RESOLUTION NO. 2013-066

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE REPLACEMENT DESKTOP AND LAPTOP COMPUTER SYSTEMS AND ASSOCIATED ACCESSORIES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$112,500 FROM DELL COMPUTER CORPORATION UTILIZING THE STATE OF TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION RESOURCES CONTRACT PRICING FOR AUTOMATED INFORMATION SYSTEMS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, pursuant to the authority granted by Section 271.081 – 271.083 Local Government Code, V.T.C.A., desires to participate in the described purchasing programs of the State Catalog Purchase procedures for automated information systems; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2013-2014 budget includes \$112,500 for information technology purchases of new and replacement equipment; and

WHEREAS, City Administration prepared desktop and laptop specifications and requested vendor quotations utilizing the State of Texas Department of Information Resources contract DIR-SDD-1951; and

WHEREAS, City Administration has determined that desktops and laptops which meet specifications can be purchased from Dell Computer Corporation through the State of Texas Department of Information Resources contract DIR-SDD-1951 for an amount not to exceed \$112,500; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, finds it to be in the public interest to purchase the above described computers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take such action as necessary to purchase replacement desktop and laptop computer systems and associated accessories from Dell Computer Corporation through the State of Texas Department of Information Resources contract DIR-SDD-1951 in an amount not to exceed \$112,500.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
