Aging Infrastructure/ Expanding Capacity



Current underground storage tank (UST) was installed in 1991, which is well beyond its 30-year lifespan.



Senlac Service Center is the only location for diesel fuel, requiring fire trucks to use public gas stations.



Additionally, there is only one diesel fuel site with no backups in the event of an emergency.



Proactive replacement is essential to avoid costly emergency repairs and potential fines.





Proposed Solution:

Above Ground Fuel Tank Installation

01

Remove and Replace UST with 15,000 gallon dual fuel above ground storage tank.

02

Improved efficiency for PD and FD and provides critical backup diesel fuel capacity

03

Enhanced safety & leak detection eliminating soil contamination risks with a UST



Enhance the Justice Center secured area by increasing its size and widening its gate.
