



RESOLUTION NO. 2019-027

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, RENAMING THE BARNEY E. WOOD ATHLETIC COMPLEX THE “BARNEY WOOD BARK PARK”; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Board has recommended to the City Council that the Barney E. Wood Athletic Complex be renamed the “Barney Wood Bark Park”; and

WHEREAS, Barney Wood was a long time Parks and Recreation Board member and Chairman of that Board; and

WHEREAS, he was a longtime resident, longtime volunteer with numerous youth sports organizations in the City and he believed that quality of life was important and that parks are an important part of quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Barney was a strong advocate for all things Parks and Recreation and the Parks and Recreation Board believes his excellent service warrants keeping his name on the facility even though the use is changing; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that such name is consistent with Resolution 2015-080 which adopted a Policy for Naming and Renaming City Facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Barney E. Wood Athletic Complex shall be renamed the “Barney Wood Bark Park”.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
