



RESOLUTION NO. 2018-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A CARGO TRAILER FOR ANIMAL CONTROL ADOPTION EVENTS FROM DEERSKIN MANUFACTURING, INC. FOR \$126,940; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City, through its Animal Services Division, is a named beneficiary in the Last Will and Testament of Glenda Sue Moore and has received a significant bequest from the Moore Estate which is to be used to create a permanent wing, veterinary endowment, marker, or other permanent item as a tribute to her cats and her friend and the independent executrix of the Moore Estate, Dorothy Ray Holley; and

WHEREAS, the Animal Services Division, after consultation with and approval of Ms. Holley, is recommending that a portion of the bequest received from the Moore Estate be used to purchase and equip a cargo trailer to be used as a mobile animal adoption center; and

WHEREAS, after extensive research, City Administration has determined that a cargo trailer that conforms to the specifications required by the Animal Services Division is only manufactured by Deerskin Manufacturing, Inc. and recommends purchasing said cargo trailer in the amount of \$126,940; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, finds it to be in the public interest to concur in such recommendation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase, on behalf of the City, a custom adopting trailer from Deerskin Manufacturing, Inc. of Springtown, Texas, in an amount of \$126,940 from funds received from the Estate of Glenda Sue Moore, Deceased.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
