In twenty years, Farmers Branch is a welcoming, diverse, and evolving city that has everything our residents need.



Seven guiding values established by the community to help the City reach the vision.


Uses:

- Evaluation of applications.
- Support identified City-led projects.
- Implementation plan to identify future projects.



Implementation:


- Undertaking projects that align with the guiding values will move the city closer to the vision established by the community.
- Policy may need to be established or modified to align with the vision and guiding values.
- The implementation section assigns timeframes to projects listed in the Comprehensive Plan:
 - **❖** Short-Term (0-7 years post-adoption)
 - Mid-Term (8-14 years post-adoption)
 - **❖** Long-Term (15-20 years post-adoption)



Potential Short-Term Projects – Economic Development (Catalyst Sites)


Foot Side

Recommended (over time):

- **Conceptual Master Plan**
- Zoning, site design and building design standards
- **Public Realm Improvements**



Potential Short-Term Projects – Land Use:

- Review and revise residential zoning districts in the CZO:
 - To allow for development of missing middle housing.
- Continue Implementation of the IH-35E Corridor Vision Study:
 - Target Area Rezonings:
 - Target Areas 2, 3, & 4 are identified for rezoning.
 - Work on Target Area 2 is underway.



Potential Short-Term Projects – Housing:

- Builders of Hope Program.
- Dallas County Housing Replacement Program.






Potential Short-Term Projects – Mobility:


- Update the Trails Master Plan.
 - Identify non-motorized connections linking neighborhood and mixed-use areas.
- Initiate sidewalk gap infill program.
- Develop a program to scope, design and implement livable streets retrofits.
- Establish a safe streets campaign.
- Implement a Neighborhood Safety Improvement Program:
 - Annual crash analysis and speed data if available.
 - Traffic Calming toolkit.












Metrics and Monitoring:
