

2026 Street Section Repair

 The City of Farmers Branch outsources most street rehabilitation work and has prepared a unit price bid for the 2026 Street Section Repairs based on estimated quantities. Three bids were received on June 30, 2025, but two were disqualified for missing the mandatory prebid meeting on June 24, 2025. The low bidder was selected based on estimated quantities and proposed unit prices, which were used solely for evaluation purposes.

- Jim Bowman Construction Company, LP in the amount of \$2,080,605
- Estrada Concrete Company LLC in the amount of \$2,361,050 (disqualified)
- Apple Pavement Services in the amount of \$3,342,500 (disqualified)

- Jim Bowman Construction Company, LP. has done similar work for the City on previous projects.
- This contract is for a one-year period with renewal options for four additional one-year periods, if agreeable by both parties.
- For renewal terms, price increases may occur, however, they may not increase more than the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers from the previous twelve months up to a maximum of 5% per annum.
- This item is consistent with the City's Critical Business Outcome CB03 plan to build, and maintain high-quality public assets and infrastructure.
