

Library Cards

The Farmers Branch Manske Library issued 1,996 new library cards, an increase of over 20% from the previous year.

Library Visitors

The Farmers Branch Manske Library served over 144,280 library building visitors, a 1.6% increase from the previous year.

Net Promoter Score

The Farmers Branch Manske Library has a Net Promoter Score (NPS) of 9.2 out of 10 over the past year. A NPS over 7 is generally considered excellent.

Program Attendance

Farmers Branch Manske Library program participation has increased by 21% from the previous year.

Future Goals

A focus on strategic objective C.2. Provide attractive, unique, and connected spaces for community interaction.



Increase Advisory Boards Partnerships
