Roadmap for Mercer Median Transition



The City met with officials with the Essex Management, the Mercer median HOA management company about transition of medians from the HOA to the City.

City Council requested that staff place funding for maintenance of the medians in the FY25 Budget.

Median funding available in the FY25 budget.
Parks began hiring process for crew to maintain the medians.

Parks staff began working with the City Attorney and Essex Management Company on updating the current agreement for the transition.

Final Steps



April 1, 2025-Execute Agreement

City Council will consider approval of the agreement with Essex Management/Mercer HOA on April 1, 2025.

April 2025-Landscape update begins

HOA contractor will begin to update the median landscape on Mercer Parkway and Wittington Way. One-time payment distributed to the City from the HOA.

April 2025-City begins maintenance

City parks maintenance crews will begin regular maintenance of the medians. Fleet Division will begin process to purchase new Parks crew vehicle, with City Council Approval.

May/June 2025-HOA updates completed

HOA contractor will complete all the median landscape updates. Parks crew vehicle ordered.
