## **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-166**



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH MOBILE COMMUNICATIONS AMERICA, INC. FOR AN ELECTRONIC ACCESS CONTROL SYSTEM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$245,000.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Farmers Branch ("City") relies on an electronic access control system to secure its facilities and manage who can enter buildings like City Hall, the Police Department, and other properties; and

**WHEREAS**, the current system is outdated, difficult to maintain, no longer meets modern security standards, with hard-to-find replacement parts and software that is no longer receiving updates or support from the manufacturer; and

WHEREAS, replacing/updating the City's existing access control system will ensure the continued safety and security of our facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Administration recommends executing an agreement with Mobile Communications America, Inc. for an electronic access control system; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it to be in the public interest to approve the recommendation of the City Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council of the City of Farmers Branch authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement with Mobile Communications America, Inc. for an electronic access control system at an amount not to exceed \$245,000.00. The City Manager is further authorized to accept and approve such additional change orders and contract amendments as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, in the public interest, in compliance with applicable law and City policy, and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of funds.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
