## **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-168**



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT OF CITY'S THE DATA **BACKUP AND** INFORMATION **TECHNOLOGY** DISASTER RECOVERY **SYSTEM** ANNUAL PAYMENTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$102,000.00 AND A TOTAL THREE-YEAR PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$306,000.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Farmers Branch (the "City") relies on a data backup and IT disaster recovery system to protect critical data and ensure continuity of operations in the event of a system failure, cyberattack, or natural disaster; and

WHEREAS, ongoing maintenance and support ensures that the system functions as intended, receives regular software updates, and is backed by technical assistance when needed; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends executing a three-year agreement for the maintenance and support of the City's backup and disaster recovery system which shall provide continued access to software updates, security patches, technical support, and hardware coverage; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it to be in the public interest to approve the recommendation of the City Administration.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council of the City of Farmers Branch authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute a three-year agreement for the maintenance and support of the City's data backup and information technology disaster recovery system with annual payments not to exceed \$102,000.00 and a total three-year price not to exceed \$306,000.00. The City Manager is further authorized to accept and approve such additional change orders and contract amendments as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, in the public interest, in compliance with applicable law and City policy, and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of funds.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
