



RESOLUTION NO. 2024-168

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AND ACCEPTING CONTRACT MODIFICATION NO. 2, AMENDING THE SCOPE OF SERVICES OF THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND LOCKWOOD, ANDREWS & NEWNAM, INC., FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR EROSION REPAIRS FOR THE FARMERS BRANCH CREEK EROSION CONTROL PROJECTS REACH 2, BRINCREST DRIVE, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,378.60; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT MODIFICATION ON THE CITY'S BEHALF; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has previously entered into a Professional Services Agreement with Lockwood, Andrews & Newnam, Inc., for engineering design services for erosion repairs pursuant to the Farmers Branch Creek Erosion Control Projects Reach 2, and has entered into a previous Contract Modification extending the scope of services rendered pursuant to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, City Administration recommends that the scope of services be extended to include Contract Modification No. 2 for the design of additional erosion control improvements along Brincrest Drive; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Farmers Branch, Texas has deemed it in the best interest of the City and its citizens to concur in the above recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council accepts and approves Contract Modification No. 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A," to the Professional Services Agreement between the City and Lockwood, Andrews & Newnam, Inc., for engineering design services for erosion repairs and erosion control improvements pursuant to the Farmers Branch Creek Erosion Control Projects Reach 2, Brincrest Drive, in the amount of \$70,378.60, and further authorizes the City Manager to accept, approve and execute Contract Modification No. 2 and such change orders as the City Manager determines to be reasonable and necessary to ensure completion of the project subject to applicable city policies and state laws and, in the case of an increase in the contract price, the availability of current funds to pay such increased price.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
