file their bonds as soon as practicable after their appointment and 1 shall otherwise be fully qualified to serve as directors prior to 2 taking office. All vacancies on the board of directors shall be 3 filled by appointment to the unexpired term by the governing body 4 that appointed the director in whose position a vacancy exists; 5 provided, however, if such governing body does not fill the vacancy 6 that then exists in such position within 60 days after the date 7 such position became vacant, the unexpired term of such position 8 shall be filled by the remaining directors; and provided further, 9 that if at any time the number of directors shall be less than four 10 because of failure or refusal of one or more directors to qualify 11 to serve, or because of death or incapacity, or for any other 12 reason, then the Commissioners Court of Dallas County, Taxas, shall 13 upon consulting with the cities of Carrollton and Farmers Branch 14 appoint directors to fill all vacancies on the board. Four 15 shall constitute a quorum of any meeting, and a 16 concurrence of four directors shall be necessary in all district 17 matters; provided, however, that the board of directors shall 18 designate the proper execution of all contracts, signing of checks, 19 or handling of any other matters entered into by the board of 20 directors as shown in the official minutes of the district. 21 board of directors shall reorganize as soon as all additional 22 directors provided for herein have taken office and shall slect a 23 president, one or more vice-presidents, a macretary, 24 and The board of directors may designate one or more 25 assistant secretaries and an assistant treasurer, who may, but need 25 not be; a member of the board of directors. The secretary of 27

board of directors, or one of the assistant secretarise, shall be responsible for keeping the minutes of the meetings of the board of directors and all official records of the board, and may certify to any action taken by the board of directors. Each member of the board of directors shall receive a per dism payment of \$50 (\$35), not to exceed a maximum payment of \$200 (\$200) per month and shall be reimbursed for actual expenses approved by the board of directors. The board of directors shall hold regular and apecial meetings at such times and on such dates as the board shall determine upon giving of proper notice thereof.

Flood Control District of Dallas County, Texas, and all elections held, all contracts executed and all bonds and other obligations issued by the Farmers Branch-Carrollton Flood Control District of Dallas County, Texas, and the expenditure of the funds in payment or satisfaction thereof are hereby in all things validated, ratified, and confirmed. All bonds heretofore voted and all maintenance taxes heretofore authorized at elections held within Farmers Branch-Carrollton Flood Control District of Dallas County, Texas, may be issued, levied, and collected by the board of directors of the district without the necessity of any further elections with respect thereto.

SECTION 4. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, sentence, part, portion or provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of this Act shall nevertheless be valid and the legislature hereby declares that this Act would have

been enacted without such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, paragraph, sentence, part, portion or provision. All the terms and provisions of this Act shall be liberally construed to effectuate the purposes, powers, rights, functions, and authorities herein set forth.

section 5. The legislature specifically finds and declared that the requirements of Article XVI, Section 59(d) and Section 59(e), of the Texas Constitution, to the extent applicable, have been met and accomplished in due course, time and order and that all notice required to be given relating to this Act has been given, that all approvals required to be obtained pursuant thereto have been obtained and that the legislature has the first and power to enact this Act.

SECTION 6. The importance of this logislation and this crowded condition of the calendars in both he are preste an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
